California's education institutions, especially our public universities, are under the total control of leftists based in Sacramento. They have been creating a cultural atmosphere that seeks to redefine the identities of all the students that pass through it. The reason why each subsequent generation of Americans is more progressive than the last is because they are being greatly affected by the indoctrination of education and culture and each generation things "progress" further. 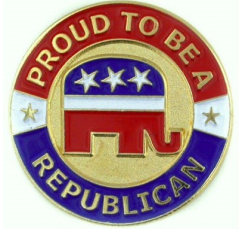

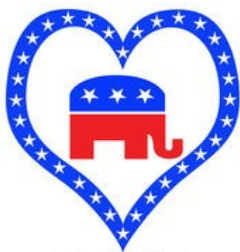
